2026 Outstanding Driver / Mechanic Award Nomination Form

To nominate a potential driver or mechanic for this annual distinguished award, complete this form and return it along with any **supporting information to be shared at the awards luncheon**, by email (video, newspaper article, digital picture, etc.), to the WSBA Office. One service award will be given per driver or mechanic. If a driver or mechanic is nominated by more than one employer, the first referral received will be the one rewarded. The awards highlight the important roles these individuals play in promoting safety, education, and professionalism. **Nominations must be made by the Employer or Supervisor who has the authority to nominate an employee.**

All nominations, including all verifying information and **photos, MUST be received by Thursday, May 21, 2026.**

Awards will be presented at the WSBA Convention Wednesday luncheon on June 24, at Marriott, Middleton.

Awardees are allowed one guest to attend the lunch complimentary. Additional guests are \$30/each for lunch.

Eligibility

1. The driver or mechanic's company must have been a member in good standing of WSBA for at least three consecutive years.
2. An individual is eligible to win the award once.
3. A driver must have exhibited excellence in pupil transportation.
4. A driver must have an acceptable safe driving record and have driven for at least three years.
5. A mechanic must have at least three years of experience working on school buses.
6. Supervisors who actually perform maintenance and/or drive on a regular basis are eligible.
